

How Work-Study Works!

Do you have Federal Work-

Study? If you are a U.S. citizen or permanent resident, you may be eligible for Federal Work-Study (FWS) through the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). FWS allows you to earn money to help pay for your education. You can work on campus or at an approved off-campus location. The amount you can earn is based on your financial need and the number of credits you are taking. You must be registered for at least 6 credits to be eligible for FWS. If you are not currently registered for classes, you may be able to register for a reduced course load (RCL) to qualify for FWS.
